

Always Keep Your Violin and Bow in Perfect Condition and Spotlessly Clean!

Great importance attaches to the size of the violin and bow with which a beginner starts. Both must neither be *too large* nor *too small* and a mistake in this respect is liable to increase the difficulties of the pupil to a very considerable extent. To make sure, the teacher should always select the violin and bow, as he or she is best qualified to judge of the practical needs of the beginner.

When you come for a lesson: "Don't Make Excuses! Make Good!" (Remark by Professor Leopold Auer)

The above is one of the first of Prof. Leopold Auer's teaching principles and remarks to be applied to the general instructive plan of this Method; others of equal importance are mentioned throughout this Method in his customary concise, authoritative manner and always signed with his initials: L.A. Now in its seventh year, the 2018 Julian Family Fiddle Camp (JFFC 2018) will follow tradition by bringing back some of its previous talent, as well as add several new artists to its string of great musicians and teachers. In addition to other newcomers, JFFC 2018 will enjoy the instructional talents of brother and sister duo, **Tashina and Tristan Clarridge** who, along with **Simon Chrisman**, comprise the core of one of today's most acclaimed acoustic bands, the <u>Bee</u> <u>Eaters</u> - and, yes, they'll be performing Saturday evening at the camp. While a master of several music genres, Tashina will lead a class on Celtic-inspired fiddle. Tristan, a master fiddler and tenor guitar player, is also an exceptional cellist. Through Tristan, JFFC will, for the first time, offer an opportunity for cellists to learn new stylings and approaches to music, and to expand their repertoires to include a variety of traditional folk tunes. Simon Chrisman is one of the country's top hammer dulcimer and upright bass players. At JFFC 2018,

Simon will focus instruction on upright bass, helping players improve intonation, note selection and timing, with emphasis on how to hold the "groove" and provide strong, reliable support for band. In addition to teaching substantive group classes on their respective instruments, Tashina, Tristan and Simon will lead a special multi-day workshop on music collaboration - a great opportunity for you, your bandmates, and any/all who like to jam to gain insight on how to listen, assess and add to the music's overall interest, sound and fun.

Formal registration for JFFC 2018 will open November 15th, 2017, with notice and registration information sent via email just prior. As in the past, our space will be limited, with priority to those registering and paying their fees early. HOLIDAY JELLO SALAD

et

2 (6oz.) Jello (red) (I use Raspberry)
4 cups boiling water
16 oz. Fancy Berry Medley
12 oz. raspberries
16 oz. Marion blackberries
1 (20 oz. can crushed pineapple, juice included

Dissolve Jello in boiling water and add all 3 packages of frozen berries and stir well. Jello becomes slightly thickened, then add crushed pineapple, juice and all. Mix and poor into serving bowl(s). Will not mold. Makes 12 servings.

Roll lemons with the palm of your hand on the counter top before cutting and juicing. This will burst the tiny juice-filled cells in the lemon's flesh allowing more of the juice to be extracted.




